As a contributing artist there are a few gallery guidelines we expect you to follow. If you do not follow these guidelines your work will not be included in the show. Your entry into the show implies your agreement with these guidelines.

1. All works entered must originate with the artist submitting them. No copyrighted materials or AI generated/enhanced works may be submitted for this exhibition.

2. Each artist may submit **one piece** of art. Each piece must not exceed 24 inches in height, width, or depth. All artwork must be ready to hang. Framed or matted, it must have **wire** across the back by which to be hung by a single nail. Sculpture must be stable and able to stand on its own.

3. Completely fill out the *Entry Application* and an *Entry Label*. Cut out the Entry Label and firmly attach to your artwork - on the lower back of 2D work or the bottom of 3D artwork. If your work is not for sale, mark the price as NFS. Please print clearly and fill out each form thoroughly.

4. Entries must be submitted in person during the designated entry dates. All submitted works must remain on view in the gallery until the end of the exhibition and picked up ASAP following the close of the show. Any works left for more than one month after the closing date will be considered a donation to TASI.

5. TASI takes a 30% commission on all sales, so work should be priced with that in mind. All transactions will be conducted by The Art Studio, Inc. Sales tax is collected at the time of sale. A check will be mailed to the artist for any sold work.

6. All work is presented at your own risk, as TASI has no insurance for the protection of art. All precautions will be taken to protect the art but we are not responsible for loss or damage of your work, especially if it falls off the wall due to faulty hanging apparatus.
